

## JUNIOR YEAR COLLEGE CALENDAR

- January - June** Research/apply for summer options (academic programs, volunteer opportunities, summer jobs, camps, etc.)
- January - March** Individual meetings for each junior with Mrs. Skiff or Ms. Wilson using the completed green College Admissions Form as a springboard for conversation
- February** ACT is offered.
- March**
- SAT is offered.
  - Students are encouraged to use March vacation to make initial visits to colleges and universities.
- April** ACT is offered.
- April - May** Family conferences with Mrs. Skiff or Ms. Wilson
- May**
- SAT is offered.
  - Completed Common Application, with essay, is due.
  - Students and parents should make tentative plans about which colleges to consider. Considerations such as academic programs, geographical location, size, campus facilities, and overall cost might be part of this preliminary survey. The student, parents, and college counselor will discuss a range of colleges that match the student's career plans, interests, and abilities. By the end of the junior year all students should have made some plans for summer college visits.
  - Students will each ask two teachers for the favor of a recommendation letter.
- June**
- SAT, SAT Subject Tests, and ACT are offered.
  - Parent "Brag Sheets" are due to Mrs. Skiff or Ms. Wilson.
- June-August**
- College visits
  - Students should work on applications and essays.
- August**
- Student "Brag Sheets" are due to Mrs. Skiff and Ms. Wilson.
